Update from NHS England:

- Soon to launch: a national metric for CYP MH, of reliable improvement in symptoms and functioning in an appropriate outcome measure. 2018/19 will be a shadow year to assure the metric, and support providers in collecting and flowing the metric to the MHSDS, with a view to publish in the MHSDS monthly publications from April 2019. There is more information on this coming out shortly.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ ICHOM will work with global experts in the field to develop these mental health related standard sets.❖ NHS England (Mental Health Policy Team) will agree with ICHOM on ways of working. This will include identifying experts to support the working groups of the standard sets development and regular updates of the agreed programme of work.❖ ICHOM will use their networks to promote the use of these 6 sets globally, supporting their clinically use and adoption in mental health service delivery and encourage the use and standardisation of the measurement of outcomes internationally.

- Four month statutory consultation likely to be released around October.

- Key proposals:

- Proposals to move towards a blended payment approach.
- IAPT – proposal to publish non mandatory benchmark prices for ‘core’ IAPT services.
- Tariff deflator of 0.1% for mental health (0.4% for acutes).
- Proposed update to the market forces factor (last updated in 2010/11) – suggestion (if approved) of a phased transition which will be part of commissioners’ allocations.
