

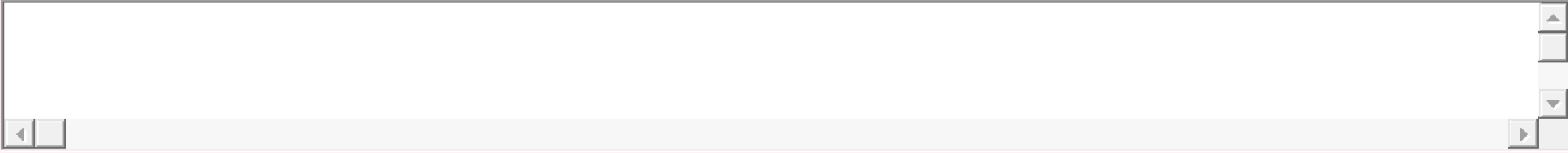

## Client tools to maintain safety:

### [My Crisis Plan](#)

**i** My Crisis Plan - a co-produced tool used by the person to help identify what they feel like and how they behave when they are in mental health crisis. The tool also supports the person to identify what support they want in a crisis and how they want services to work with them.

### [My Safety Plan](#)

**i** My Safety Plan - a co-produced tool used by the person to help identify things which make them unsafe, what actions they will take to be safe and what support they want from others. There is also a space to record things the professional thinks can make the person unsafe, but the person disagrees with. Used for people who have 'risks' but who don't necessarily go into mental health crisis.

### [Combined Crisis and Safety Plan](#)

**i** Combined Crisis and Safety Plan - a combined version of both tools for people with needs who span both.
